## Yorkshire in Bloom results

The results for all our entries in the Yorkshire in Bloom competition 2024 – the village and

businesses – will be publicised on the village website and in November's Bulletin.

#### Have you tried bulb planting?

Bulbs are useful for adding colour to spring borders. Tulips come in all shades, from dark purple to white, and bloom at a time of year when many plants offer muted colours. Other bulbs, such as snowdrops and scillas, brighten up the short days of very early spring. Most bulbs are acquired and planted when dry, in a dormant, leafless, rootless state. Plant as soon as possible. The best time is now. Aim to plant in groups of at least six, as the more bulbs that are grouped together, the

better the display. Typically, 25 to 50 bulbs may be needed to make an impressive show.

And now for something completely different **Dog poo bags** 

For some years Village in Bloom has been putting Doggie Poo bags in a container attached to the gate at the entrance to Centenary Wood for the convenience of dog walkers. The poo bags and sometimes the containers have been stolen on a regular basis. The bags and containers have been replaced using In Bloom funds. We have now decided not to replace the bags. In any case, responsible dog owners will carry their own.



continuing love of life, her humour and her interest in others.






















#### Summer Holidays by Year 2 pupils






